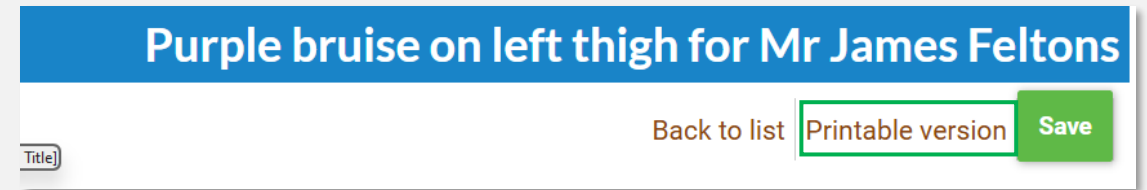
OVERVIEW

This user guide will walk you through the new wound care plan printout.

The wound & infections care plan printout has been updated to provide a much clearer print layout, which enables all wound review details to be viewed in their entirety with an easier to read format. This ensures when wound care plans need to be shared with GPs or other Health Care Professionals, there is no missed information and a clear picture of the wound's progression can be provided.

STEP 2

Clicking on this link, will take you through to a print preview of the report, which now has an improved look and feel.
